SUBJECT: Peace March

The peace march in Pasco this after was estimated at about 700 people that gathered in Volunteer Park at about noon. The group peacefully walked to 10th and Lewis. They spent a couple of hours at the 10 and Lewis location. Police had no problem reports up to this point.

At about 6:30 pm a group of about 75 people did not want to leave the 10th and Lewis Street and walked into the intersection where they blocked traffic.

Pasco Police called for assistance from Tri-City police agencies and about 30 law enforcement officers took control of the 10 and Lewis intersection with no resistance by those that were blocking traffic.

Law enforcement had no arrests related to the march and no additional problems.
