Every Kid Sports will begin accepting Every Kid Sports Pass applications starting Friday, May 15th. Due to COVID-19, we are making modifications to our application process since there is still the possibility of sports being suspended indefinitely in some areas.

Please note these important processes:

- We will require that parents submit a contact name, phone, email and address of the youth sport organization (YSO) with whom they are registering their child.
- When an application is approved, the parent and YSO will receive a confirmation email.
- Payment will not be sent to the YSO until two weeks prior to the season start date.
- Confirmation from the YSO that the season will continue as planned will be required before payment is sent.
- All checks will be sent directly to the YSO, so it is important for parents to enter the correct mailing address for the YSO on the application.
- We encourage YSO's to accept registration with delayed payment while these processes are in place.
