

Pasco Youth Scholarship Fund

Thank you for your interest in the City of Pasco Recreation Youth Scholarship. Applications must be submitted prior to registration and are not excepted during swim lesson registration. The application process takes time, so apply early. Scholarships are valid May-April, with applications beginning April 1 for the current year.

Youth Scholarship Fund

The Pasco Youth Scholarship Fund is provided by a grant through the Federal Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Block Grant program, individuals, social groups, clubs, businesses and service organizations that allows eligible youth to participate in recreational programs and activities offered through Pasco Recreation Services.

An application must be completed by a parent or legal guardian and submitted to Recreation Services with qualifying documentation that includes proof of residency in the City limits of Pasco by the parent or legal guardian of the child(ren) requesting funds and submitted in person. A copy of last year's 1040 tax form is also required to show proof of income. All household members must provide proof of income and children on the application must be claimed on the documentation to qualify.

Application Documents

- A current rental lease or utility bill (water bill, phone bill, PUD, etc.) showing the adult's name and address being used.
- A copy of last year's Income Tax Return, with W-2s for all household members with an income.
- Photo identification of the parent or legal guardian (driver's license, state ID card, etc.)
